2nd congress of Chilean Society of Oncology Pharmacy

Among the international speakers we had the great honour of having the participation of an ESOP member such as Dr. Jean Vigneron, with the upgrade of stabilities and critical Reading or fan article on stability.



We were also able to count via streaming, with the participation of Dr. Ewelina Korczowska from Poland, with the topic White areas and surface contamination with antineoplastics and finally **Monica Santimaria** and Cecilia Giron from Italy. They spoke about radiopharmacy and its development in Italy, this last topic attracted our attention as a possible area of development for pharmacists.

Afterwards, as is traditional in our meetings, we had a closing dinner, where we enjoyed the time and danced to encourage physical activity after 3 years of pandemic.
