ABSTRACT

EAHP's annual congress is the largest congress for hospital pharmacy in Europe and is attended by professionals from all over the world. About 3'000 hospital pharmacists are expected to attend the 16th Congress of the EAHP next 30 March –1 April 2011 at the Austria Center Vienna.

"Hospital Pharmacists in a changing world - opportunities and challenges" will be the frame for the presentations at the Vienna 2011 EAHP Congress.

Most hospital pharmacists across Europe feel the need for development of skills and services for the future of their profession. The challenges are mostly coming from economy but also expectations and needs for new hospital pharmacy services are the opportunities and driving forces in the process of change.

Keynote presentations such as "Do we live in an era of change or in a changing era" will open your eyes for the general trend and prepare you for having a look on "Changing the professional image of the hospital pharmacist". As a tool a proposal for "Change management in hospital pharmacy" will be presented.

Seminars which are open for interactions with the speakers will be dealing with the need for specialisation for the hospital pharmacist as seen in some European countries but missing in most others. Distribution of drugs is still a major object for the hospital pharmacist: is this going to continue and, if yes, how do we develop this area by adding new qualities to an old service. At the same time, the strategy for hospital pharmacy production/preparation of drugs, are under evaluation in the light of the need for ready to use and safe to handle drugs in the hospital. All subjects for presentations are in the form of seminars with presentations by 2 speakers and time for questions.

Along with keynotes and seminars there will also be workshops within the theme of the congress among these providing inspiration within clinical pharmacy and medical devices.
